Citizen involvement leads to Three Arrests For Multiple Law Violations

New Orleans, LA – Members of the Fourth District Narcotics Detectives unit pursued citizen complaints that lead to the arrest of 63-Year-old Walter Lucas, 24-year-old Brian Patterson and 20-year Jabari Johnson. The arrests took place June 21, 2010, in Algiers during surveillance that was set after CrimeStoppers tips were given by concerned citizens.

Superintendent of Police, Ronal Serpas said, “When concerned citizens get involved in helping the Police the results can be very rewarding”.

The first arrest took place in the 1000 block of Leboeuf Street during surveillance, when a suspect was stopped and found to be wanted and in possession of Hydrocodone pills. This individual was later identified as Walter Lucas.

The second arrest took place in the 1700 block of Tita, where a narcotics purchase was arranged and later a suspect was followed to a residence in the 3200 block of Lawrence Street. The suspect attempted to flee, but was arrested a short while after in possession of Marijuana. This individual was later identified as Jabari Johnson.

The third arrest took place when a search warrant was executed at 3210 Lawrence Street and narcotics were confiscated. This individual was later identified as Brian Patterson.
